English is the language of the media industry. If you speak English, you won't need to rely on translations anymore to enjoy your favorite books, songs, films and TV shows.

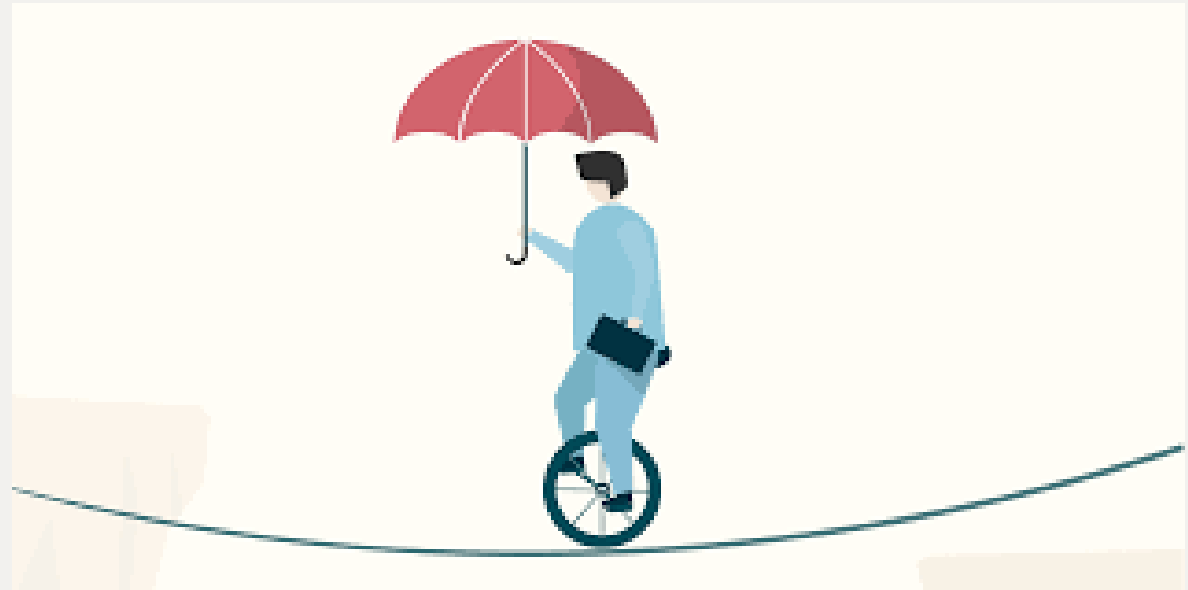

Writing Best Strategy Steps

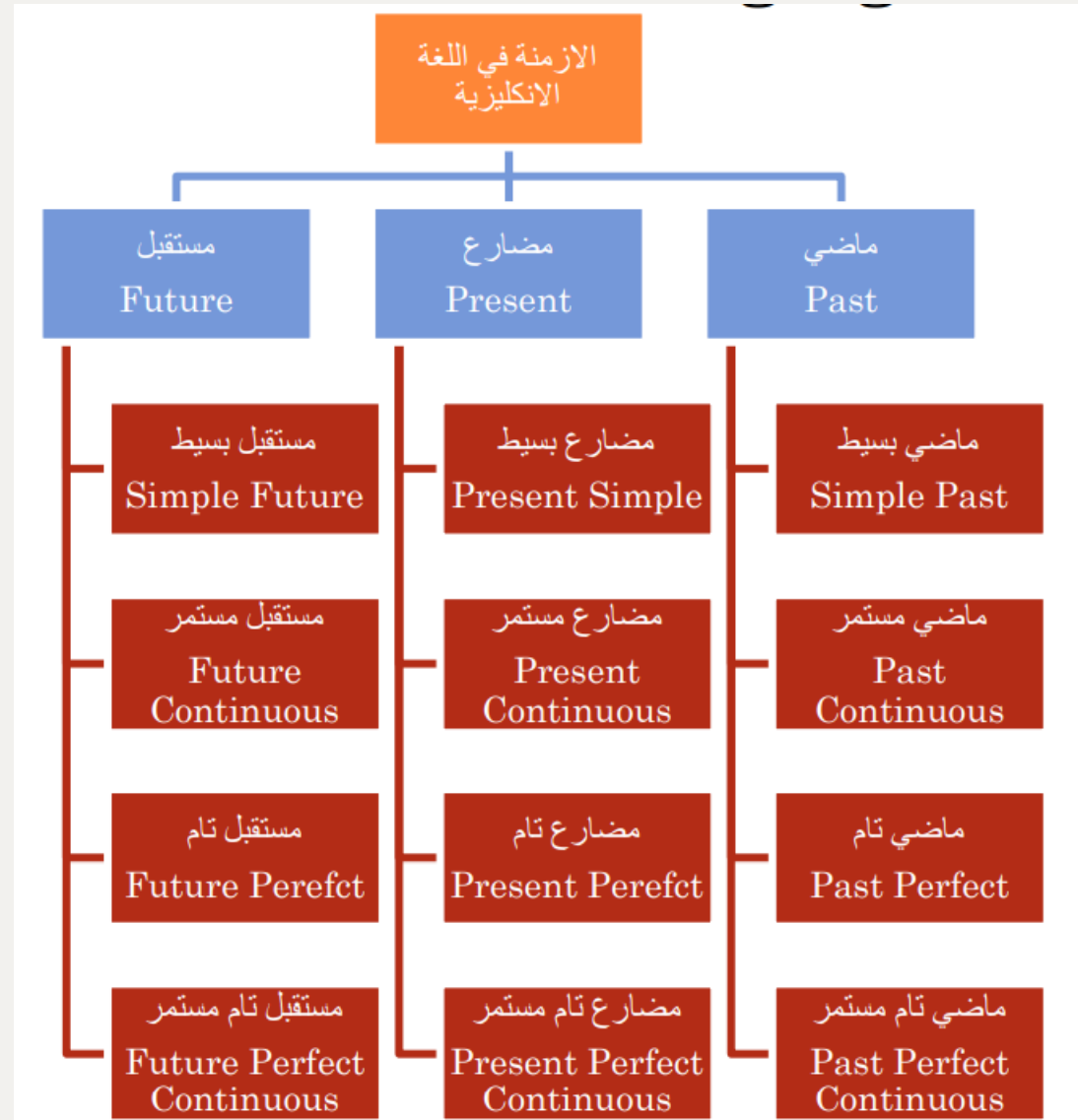
1. Memorize Vocabularies
